

ICL SURGERY DROP INSTRUCTIONS

The eye will take approximately 1 month to heal after your surgery. During this time, your vision may be blurry and you may experience temporary side effects such as: a scratching and burning sensation, excessive tearing, sensitivity to light, redness, swollen eyelids, and a foreign body sensation. You should not have significant pain and if you do, please contact your eye doctor.

Eye Shield	Protects eye while asleep	Tape over eye while sleeping for 1 week after surgery
Artificial Tears	Lubricates the eye	1 Drop as Needed

- If using artificial tears or any other drops, please wait five minutes after applying the Pred-Gati-Brom to avoid washing out the medication.
- Avoid heavy lifting, bending, and strenuous activities until next visit.
